

Wadsworth Youth Basketball League is for boys and girls in grades 3 through 8. To participate in the league, the child must reside in Wadsworth or go to school in Wadsworth. There are separate leagues for boys and girls. Teams are limited to 8 players or less. Boys' teams usually practice on Monday & Wednesday while Girls' teams practice on Tuesday & Thursday. Practices last one hour, starting as early as 5:30 p.m. with the last practice ending by 9:00 p.m. All teams follow a substitution pattern to ensure equitable playing time.

Sign-ups for all leagues begin late in September and the beginning of October. Following sign-ups, there is a player skills camp followed by a draft to determine teams. There is a participation fee, which includes the gym rentals, referee, scorers, and numbered jersey.

The 3rd & 4th grade leagues start the first of November and is over by the end of February. Teams practice twice a week and play games on Saturdays. Teams usually play 10 games. Games begin as early as 8:00 a.m. and the last game ends by 3:00 p.m. The league provides referees, but no score is kept in this instructional league.

The 5th & 6th grade leagues start the first of November and end by the first of February. Teams usually practice twice a week. Most games are played on Saturday. When a team plays a weekday game, there is only one practice that week. Teams usually play 9 games with a year-end tournament. Saturday games start as early as 8:00 a.m. and end by 3:00 p.m. Weekday games begin at 6:30 p.m. with the last game over by 9:00 p.m.

The 7th & 8th grade leagues start the first of January and end by the first of March. Teams usually practice once a week. Most games are played during the week. Teams usually play 9 games with a year-end tournament. Saturday games start as early as 8:00 a.m. and end by 3:00 p.m. Weekday games begin at 6:30 p.m. with the last game over by 9:00 p.m.
